If you want to learn the basics of canoeing or kayaking: strokes, boat control, safety and trip planning, then this is the clinic for you! This class is geared toward the beginner who wants to learn how to have a fun, safe day on the river. It is also great for the beginner who would like to work up to taking our Whitewater Clinic next spring. The clinic will take place on **Saturday**, **May 18**, **9am - 5pm**. It's open to anyone who is 12 years or older in good physical condition, with basic swimming skills and no excessive fear of being in or around the water.

- American Canoe Association certified instructors and volunteer assistant/safety persons are teaching this clinic. They will be donating their time, vehicles, and effort.
- > The size of the clinic is limited and will be filled first come, first serve. Applications are being accepted through May 17th.
- If you do not have your own equipment, contact Dynamic Earth or Ozark Mountain Trading Company and inquire about obtaining a demo kayak, or rent a canoe or kayak through James River Outfitters.
- > Bring your own lunch and drinks for the day. No pets. No alcoholic beverages on the river.\
